

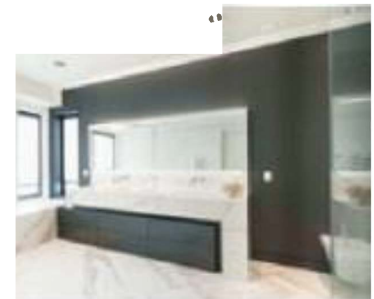
HCC-HDC JV wins Rs. 2,126 crore Mumbai Coastal Road contract

HCC Construction Company Ltd (HCC), in joint venture with Hyundai Development Corporation Ltd., has been awarded a Rs. 2,126 crore contract by the Municipal Corporation of Greater Mumbai (MCGM) for design and construction of the Mumbai Coastal Road Project, Package 1. HCC's share in the JV is 55% (Rs. 1,169 crore) and the project is to be completed in 4 years (48 months).
