Cameo laser designs allow for any design or image to be etched in an Electric Mirror lighted mirror. The opacity of the design allows light to glow through the pattern, according to the company. There are five standard patterns, including Mojave (shown), or a custom one can be created.



The Dressage Free-Standing Vanity from Graff, designed by Nespoli and Novara Design Studio, features a minimalist, sawhorse shape base that conceals all plumbing. It is available in three finishes—Canaletto walnut, oak, and wenge—and is fully customizable.



Majestic Mirror & Frame's Strand XL is an LED-backlit mirror with T5 LED Light Tube Technology. Light appears on all four sides of the frameless design, and its standard size is 28 in. x 42 in.



The Vento Collection from Robow, designed by Pininfarina, is inspired by snowdrifts carved by fast, strong winds, according to the company. The vanity is available in two sizes and finishes.



The Armadi Art Acqua Collection of wall-mounted vanities from Topex Design are available in three series—Slim, Radius (shown) and Flat—and 32 different finishes. They are made of solid aluminum and are 100% waterproof, according to the company.



Waterworks' Daphne Metal Rectangular Wall Mounted Triptych Mirror is reminiscent of a 1920s French-style triptych mirror. Its handcrafted hinges allow the outer leaves to fold into and away from the rounded-frame center.
