These three products were all showcased at ISH, the world's leading trade fair for the bathroom experience held in Frankfurt, Germany in March, introducing an undeniably refreshing touch of nature to the design space.

GRAFE

Catch a glimpse into the future of luxury with the Ametis shower column by GRAFF. Revolutionary in both design and performance, the Ametis showerhead combines careful engineering with leading technology to transform and inspire the bath space.

Designer Davide Oppizzi uses RGB LED lighting to create a futuristic feel, belanced by elegant curves and fluid shapes that exude the essence of nature, At 65 inches tall, the indirect lighting within the overhead ring provides a soft glow below, equipped with four color options: white, red, green and blue. Body sprays are placed along the column to engage at the senses, turning the bathing experience into a tranquil escape.

Standing beneath the Ametis showerhead, you'll find yourself in the space between the universe above and ocean below, as Oppizzi intended to capture the fusion of these two elements through his ultra-modern design. The Ametis showerhead is available in white and black finishes, with pricing starting at \$15,000.

The defined edges and clean lines of this contemporary design are made possible by LAUFEN's SapphireKeramik, a material with unprecedented flexural strength and durability. The Sapphire Sink marks the first time this material has been used, brought to the market after years of research and development.

Inspired by natural minerals, SapphireKeramik revolutionizes design capabilities, while providing courtless functional benefits. Not only is the material second only to diamonds in hardness, but also it can handle sharelsv cleaners and mechanical abracion to ensure the surface remains sanitary, its hardness permits thinner waits and a simplified structure, creating an architectural design that adds a modern touch to the bath space.
