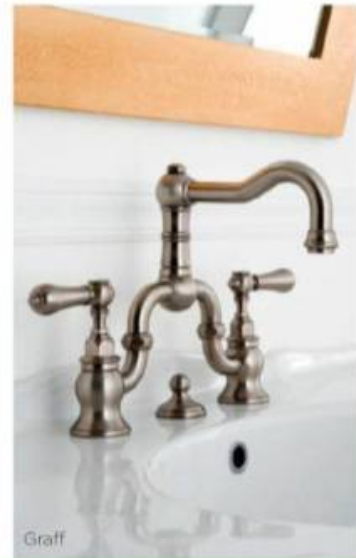

Astha Khetan, Founder, The House of Things suggests to polish copper surfaces with a soft cloth and beeswax to get a lasting shine. It is advisable to avoid abrasive cleaner or steel wool to clean copper. To remove tarnish from copper pots, rub with lemon halves dipped in salt. Most pieces of decorative copper are given a factory-applied protective coating of lacquer so they will remain clean if we occasionally wash them with lukewarm soapy water.
